The Hazardous Waste Information Network (HWIN) is a program that allows generators, carriers, and receivers of hazardous waste to inform the Ministry of the Environment (MOE) about their activities online. In addition, when removing underground storage tanks (USTs), HWIN generator and waste class registration are required. HWIN is a large part of the MOE's hazardous waste management plan. This program requires generators (users) to renew annually, ensuring the safe handling of hazardous materials.

This program includes:

- The quality of hazardous waste information; and
- The accessibility of hazardous waste information.
